

4. Sample Roof Crasher Lesson: Being a Roof Crasher, Part 1

One of you please read Luke 5:17–26.

Discuss the lengths these guys went to in order to take their friend before Jesus. Some examples you might share:

- Found a creative way to get past the crowd
- Would not give up as they wanted to help their friend
- Carried upstairs and onto a roof
- Found rope to lower him down

Ask the group to brainstorm a list of characteristics exhibited in these men. Explain that, in the coming weeks, we are going to be unpacking some of these characteristics for application in our lives. Some examples you might share are as follows:

- Commitment
- Perseverance
- Love for their friend
- Faith that he would be helped
- Creativity

Share that over time; we will unpack some of these characteristics for application in our lives.
